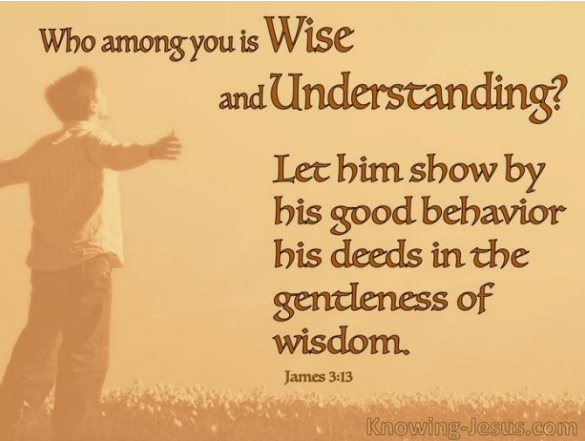
Dull’s Trip – Children & Youth Family Day at Dull’s on **Sunday, October 4th at 1PM**. Lunch & drinks will be provided.
