Youth Group – Youth group **today**. Grades 6-12 from **5:30-7:00PM**.

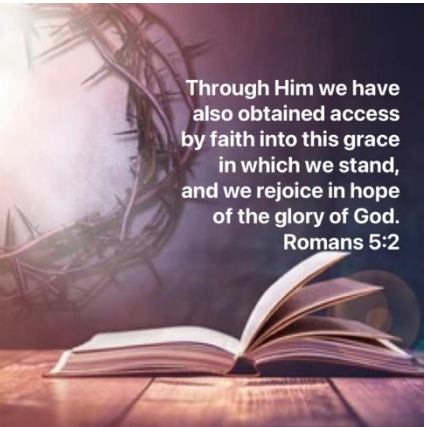
